Sheikh Abdulrahman bin Hamad bin Jassim bin Hamad Al Thani, they toured the activities held at Darb Al-saai and they were briefed on Al Shaqab, Darb Al Saai Market and Al Bidda activities. They also attended the seminar entitled "Organizations from Local to Global". The seminar was attended by Director-General of the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization "ISESCO", Director-General of the Arab League Educational, Cultural and Scientific Organization "ALECSO" and Director of the Department of Culture, Heritage and Tourism at the General Secretariat of GCC. During the tour, they were briefed on various cultural and heritage events such as Liwan Art, Al-Izba, Al-Rimy, Al-Maqtar.

H.E. Sheikh Khalifa bin Jassim Al Thani, Chairman of the Qatar Chamber, praised the new location of Darb Al-Saai in Umm Salal, expressing his admiration of the various activities and events that reflect our celebrations of Qatar National Day under the slogan "Our Unity is the Source of Our Strength", and coincides with the hosting of FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022.

H.E. praised the efforts of the Ministry of Culture and the Organizing Committee of Darb Al-Saai activities that reflects our culture and heritage, and aim to highlight the history of Qatar and its authentic heritage.



The two-day "Forum of Organizations from Local to Global," organized by the Ministry of Culture, kicked off Monday evening as part of the Darb Al Saai activities held under the slogan "Our Unity is the Source of Our Strength".

HE Minister of Culture and Chairman of the Organizing Committee for the National Day celebrations, Sheikh Abdulrahman bin Hamad Al-Thani, attended the forum along with a large number of guests of the Ministry of Culture, and Darb Al Saai audience.















Director of the Department of Culture and Arts at the Ministry of Culture Maryam Yassin Al Hammadi moderated the forum, which was attended by HE Acting Secretary-General of the Qatar National Commission for Education, Culture and Science Ali Abdul Razzaq Marafie, and Director of the Department of Culture, Tourism and Antiquities in the Secretariat General of Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf (GCC) Dr. Saad bin Mohamed Al Zughaibi, HE Director-General of the Arab League Educational, Cultural and Scientific Organization (ALECSO) Dr. Mohamed Ould Amar, and HE Director-General of the Islamic World Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ICESCO) Dr. Salim bin Mohammed Al Malik.

Also, the Representative of the United Nations Educational and Scientific Organization and Culture (UNESCO) in the Arab Gulf States and Yemen and Director of the UNESCO Office in Doha, Salah El Din Zaki Khaled, and Program Specialist in the Cultural Sector at the UNESCO Doha Office Rasul Samadov participated in the forum.

Ali Abdul Razzaq Marafie gave an introduction to the objectives and tasks of the Qatar National Commission for Education, Culture and Science, which was established on Feb. 25, 1962, to contribute to achieving the goals of international organizations in line with the goals of education in the State of Qatar and its objectives through implementing many programs, projects and activities in various fields, in cooperation and coordination with national, regional and international partners to promote citizenship, human rights, justice, and human dignity.

He added that the commission seeks to make the membership of the State of Qatar in international, regional, and Arab organizations a successful investment that benefits all aspects of educational, scientific, and cultural activity in the country and contribution to the national development process in accordance with the Qatar National Vision 2030.

He explained that the commission provides support to the competent agencies in the country to meet the needs of the ministries and institutions concerned in the country regarding the activities and programs of organizations related to education, culture, and science.











The artist Fahd Al-Maadeed found a space to highlight his artistic talent near the main corridor at Darb Al-Saai, so he painted with his brush bright drawings that reflects an aspect of the innate Qatari environment.

A drawing of the well-known Qatari horse "Marwan Al Shaqab" appeared with its inherited beauty, but the artist Al-Maadeed was not satisfied with the real colors of the horse, but rather painted two other horses in green and blue, saying that he wanted to provoke the public with these two colors and present something different. Fahd Al-Maadeed was not enough with drawing the horses, but added to its side a drawing of the Samar tree with its branches that spread joy, as well as a drawing of the Qatari kindergarten in which the Sidra tree is in addition to a water stream in a depiction of the most beautiful months of the year and the Qatari spring, especially in the northern regions of the country.

Regarding the most prominent thing that attracted the audience of Darb Al-Saai to the drawings, Fahd Al-Maadeed said: His drawing directly in front of the audience had great impression on the audience, especially from the children, and therefore the audience eagerly followed the completion of the artistic paintings that will remain in front of the visitors of Darb Al-Saai in his new and permanent location.


